## 2024 CAMPSITE RULES

- 1. Campsites open at 6:30 am
- 2. Each site will be given 2 passes for their one vehicle. One pass is to be given to security as your **ONE** vehicle enters the campsite area and the other pass is to be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle coming into the site
- 3. Each campsite will be allowed **ONE** vehicle to enter. RV sites will be allowed **ONE** RV or **TWO** vehicles.
- 4. Once a vehicle leaves from the campsite area there will be no re-entry allowed and no other vehicle may enter the site.
- 5. What ever your team is bringing in (food, drinks) must be in that **ONE** vehicle. Suggestion: Have your entire team meet in advance and load all ice chests and food into the one vehicle that will be coming in. **NO GLASS IS ALLOWED!!** All glass bottles will be confiscated.
- 6. Team members will be allowed to walk into the campsite area with their chairs and personal belongings. **HOWEVER, NO ICE CHESTS, OR ALCOHOL can be walked into the area.** All bags will be checked upon entry into Stramler Park.
- 7. Each team must stay within their marked off area. Please do not crowd into neighboring campsites. Please be respectful of the teams around you.
- 8. Each team is responsible for cleaning up their site after they are done. **DO NOT LEAVE ANY GARBAGE BEHIND TAKE IT WITH YOU!!!**
- 9. **CAPTAINS,** you are responsible for your team as well as your spectators. Any site/person/team found to be unruly/out of control will result in the ENTIRE TEAM being removed from the campsite area and forfeiture of games.
- 10. **Absolutely NO MUSIC TO BE PLAYED AT INDIVIDUAL CAMPSITES!** Due to the number of complaints and fights that have ensued over music, campsites are no longer allowed to have music playing. We are adding speakers in the back area so that you can hear the music that the DJ is playing. This will also allow for teams to easily hear announcements being made.
- 11. NO MINORS ARE TO BE IN POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL!! It is illegal for any minor to consume alcohol and it is the responsibility of the Team captain to monitor and enforce this rule.
- 12. REMEMBER THAT THIS IS FOR CHARITY HAVE FUN!! THANK YOU FOR YOUR SUPPORT!!

I have read all rules and agree to hold my team responsible for following such rules. As team captain I accept full responsibility for my team and all spectators at my campsite. I agree that all persons consuming alcohol at my campsite are 21 years of age or older. I will at no time offer any alcohol to any minor. I understand that if my team is found to be in violation of any rule, we will be asked to vacate the campsite. If asked to vacate campsite there will be refund of tournament entry fees or campsite fees.
